# Re-Entering Well Task Force Update

# **Task Force Purpose**

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, it is essential that the church remains prayerful and steadfast amid the uncertainty of the times. Following the directive of Bishop Easterling, St. Mark has closed the building for indoor activities and worship. For a time, driven by our love for our neighbor, we have not assembled in person to worship to slow the spread of the virus and to protect the vulnerable.

As mandated by the United Methodist Conference, churches were to *"create a Task Force to discern how to best re-enter the building while putting a priority on life amid the coronavirus pandemic."* In anticipation of a return to in-person gatherings, a Re-Entering Well Task Force was created to plan the phased-in reopening of St. Mark once it is safe to do so as well as ensure our congregation and community continue to feel the church's seamless presence. Much prayer and discussion are taking place weekly to ensure the safe return to our corporate worship.

# **Task Force Charge**

Using the Key Questions (listed to the right), as Guidelines, the Task Force is charged with, among other things to:

- Consider the percentage of congregants who are vulnerable to the virus and establish safety procedures and policies necessary to create a safe space for people to worship
- Review the configuration of the physical space including parking lots, narthex, sanctuary, bathrooms, resource/ conference rooms, nursery and educational building and determining what actions are necessary to meet health guidelines.
- Ensure an adequate supply of cleaning and sanitization products, hand sanitizers, and masks to meet CDC guideline to mitigate risk.

# Task Force Decisions/Actions/Progress to Date Include:

- Inclusion of Communion in virtual services and the distribution of individually wrapped Communion sets for use during those services
- Conducting socially distanced outdoor services with contact tracing
- Removal of hymnals and bibles from the sanctuary for cleaning and storage
- Stocking adequate supply of hand sanitizer, masks and cleaning supplies
- Communicating activities via E-Blast, Church website and social media
- Continued community support via existing food distribution programs: LOH Food Center, SHARE, and Pantry On The Go
- Working on upgrades to our AV System to enhance current broadcasting capabilities as well as future in-house and broadcasting services

*NOTE:* Safe Re-Entering under current guidelines will not likely be accomplished before January 2021

### Task Force Key Questions

WHAT? Consider the availability of required supplies, such as masks and hand sanitizer, and how you will adhere to all CDC and local health guidelines to mitigate risk.

WHO? Consider the percentage of congregants who are vulnerable to the virus, and take into account the high degree of discipline that will be necessary in order for the pastor and congregation to be vigilant about adhering to guidelines and helping others do the same.

WHERE? Consider the size and configuration of your space(s) including parking lots, foyers, sanctuary, bathrooms, classrooms, etc. and what that means in terms of meeting health guidelines.
